

Getting to Brussels

Brussels Airport is very close to the city – it takes around 20 minutes by train from the Brussels Airport to Gare Centrale (Central Station). The airport train station is located below the terminal (basement level–1). Up to 6 trains an hour connect the airport to Brussels Central Station. Tickets are on sale at the stations. A single fare costs EUR 8.60.

The city centre is also well connected by bus. From Monday to Friday until 8 PM the Airport Line (bus number 12) halts at the most important stops in Brussels. After 8 PM and at the weekends, the line 12 is replaced by line 21.

Charleroi Airport is a bit further away from the city centre – it takes around 1 hour by shuttle from the airport to Bruxelles Midi (South Station). You can buy the tickets online.

sightseeing

Have a walk around the charming Grand-Place – and take a picture with Manneken Pis, who's just around the corner. Follow the comic book route around the city to see some amazing artworks. Would you rather stay inside because of the (in)famous Belgian weather? Go see the Magritte Museum!

food & drink

Looking for a place to eat close to the European quarter? We recommend Ergon and Kitchen 151, excellent Mediterranean restaurants. Going to the city centre? Pass by Les Filles, a cosy place with great seasonal food. Going out for drinks? Try any bar at Place Saint-Géry or Place Flagey!

Make sure you don't miss Horta Inside Out, a series of guided tours, exhibitions, conferences and other events that will take place throughout the year. getting around

We recommend using public transportation in Brussels. You can buy tickets from Kiosks, Bootiks (at the metro stops) and GO! vending machines. Prices vary between 2,10 € (single fare) to 14 € (10 journeys).
